For unknown words, try to use the vocabulary you know to elaborate a concept or definition, so you extend you response to convey meaning.

EXTENSIVE

Go for more. Read a book, story or magazine aloud it definitely help with fluency.



Memorize simple sentences to complex ones try to use them on your every day speech.
